Preparing for Surgery:

- Please notify a pre-op nurse IMMEDIATELY between 8:00am and 2:00pm at 662-349-0910 if you:
 - 1) are allergic to LATEX
 - 2) may possibly be PREGNANT
 - 3) are taking DIET PILLS
 - 4) have any SPECIAL NEEDS.

Prior to Surgery: Expect 2 Phone Calls

- A preoperative nurse will call you between the hours of 8:00am and 2:00pm 3 days prior to surgery to review your medical history from Simple Admit and give pre-surgery instructions.
- You will be asked to arrive 1-2 hours prior to your surgery time.
- Our business office will verify your insurance and benefits.
 We will contact you about your financial obligations. You will need to be prepared to pay any deductible and co-insurance on the day of surgery. The Center accepts cash, cashier's checks, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover, and Care Credit.

Day of Surgery:

- Do not eat or drink **ANYTHING** after midnight the night before surgery. This includes gum, candy, water, and smokeless tobacco.
- Have a responsible adult drive you to the center, come inside with you during your entire stay here, then drive you home.
- Bring your insurance cards, picture ID, and any financial responsibilities.
- Leave all jewelry, PIERCINGS, and valuables at home.
- If you take any heart, blood pressure, seizure, asthma or reflux medication, you MAY take it with a small sip of water and bring them with you.
- If you are diabetic, DO NOT take your medications. Please bring them with you.
- Bring your medication bottles and/or a complete list of medications with the dosages.
- Wear cotton undergarments if possible.

After the Surgery:

- Verbal and written instructions will be given to you and your reponsible party regarding your home care.
- A nurse will call you at home to check on your progress and to answer any questions the following business day.
- If you have any questions or concerns about your progress, call your doctor.
